In early December, working with our partners, Salvation Army and CAP (Christians Against Poverty), many of you helped to pack 360 bags for Christmas Hampers filled with over four tonnes of food and toiletries generously supplied by you, our supporters. Local primary schools decorated labels for each bag.



Following the Christmas Hamper campaign we have packed a further 26 Christmas Day boxes to go to the Salvation Army and 17 bags to Larne Lighthouse for their Christmas day event. We have also been able to help other groups with items of food as they work to support families during these difficult days. None of this work is possible without your support and we are humbled by it.
